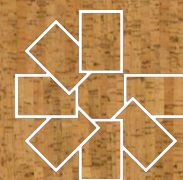

# Care advice

Cork is a natural material with unique qualities and a warm, tactile expression. It is lightweight, elastic and durable, while also offering both thermal and acoustic insulating properties. Cork is naturally resistant to liquids and provides good fire resistance.

To maintain the material's properties over time, an indoor climate with a relative humidity of 35–65% at approximately 20°C is recommended. Prolonged dry conditions, such as during heating seasons, may cause slight shrinkage, making joints more visible. If necessary, humidifiers may be used to help maintain a stable indoor climate.

As cork is a natural material, slight colour changes may occur over time, particularly when exposed to direct sunlight.

## Regular maintenance

For regular cleaning, a mild solution of soap and water is recommended. Always use a clean, uncoloured cloth to avoid discolouration or transfer of colour onto the surface.

If more thorough cleaning is required, a pH-neutral cleaning agent suitable for the material is recommended. After cleaning, the surface should be thoroughly wiped with clean water and then dried using an absorbent cloth to remove any residue.

Inspect the surface after cleaning and repeat the treatment if necessary.
